

# Key Investor Information

## 7IM SELECT MODERATELY ADVENTUROUS FUND, CLASS E (Accumulation)

A sub-fund of 7IM Opportunity Funds. This sub-fund is managed by Seven Investment Management LLP. (ISIN: GB00BQKRXQ93)

### Objectives and investment policy

#### Objective

The fund aims to provide a return made up of capital growth with some income over the medium to longer term (5 years or more).

#### Investment Policy

The fund invests at least 80% of its assets in other funds managed both by the manager and by selected third party managers, including open-ended and closed-ended funds and exchange traded funds (ETFs), other transferable securities such as structured products, and also money market funds and money market instruments used for liquidity management as cover for investment in futures contracts.

Up to 20% of the fund will be invested in assets such as cash, and deposits, and may also include the use of money market funds and money market instruments, for more general liquidity purposes. This is additional to the holding of such assets as cover for futures contracts as noted above.

#### Essential features of the fund:

- Investment in other funds is determined on the basis of a number of factors including level of returns, underlying asset class, Manager's investment process and level of risk.
- The fund has no specific target market, asset class or geographic sector.
- You can buy and sell shares in the fund on each UK business day.
- Income from the fund will be added to the value of your investment.
- Derivatives are used for investment purposes and to manage the risk profile of the fund.
- Recommendation: This fund may not be appropriate for investors who plan to withdraw their money within 5 years.

#### Investment Strategy

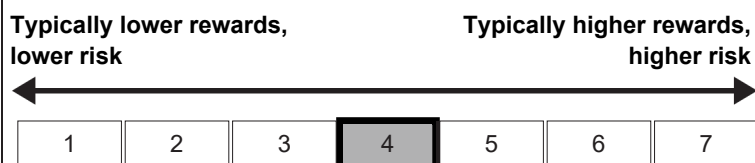
The fund will invest in a select number of investments compared to other funds in the manager's range. The 7IM Select funds range is made up of a range of four funds with different risk profiles. The fund is at the higher end of the risk spectrum of the funds in the range, with the 7IM Select Moderately Cautious Fund and the 7IM Select Balanced Fund below it and the 7IM Select Adventurous Fund above it at the top end. The fund aims to reduce the effects of falling markets on the value of the fund, by using derivatives or negatively correlated assets (i.e. assets with values that may move in the opposite direction).

#### Performance Comparator

The fund's performance will be compared to the ARC Sterling Steady Growth Private Client Index which has been chosen because it is representative of the fund's risk profile and the type of assets in which it invests. It is therefore an appropriate comparator for the fund's performance.

### Risk and reward profile

The Risk and Reward Indicator table demonstrates where the Fund ranks in terms of its potential risk and reward. The higher the rank the greater the potential reward but the greater the risk of losing money. It is based on past data, may change over time and may not be a reliable indication of the future risk profile of the Fund. The shaded area in the table below shows the Fund's ranking on the Risk and Reward Indicator.



- The lowest number on the scale does not mean that a fund is risk free.
- The fund has been classed as 4 because its volatility has been measured as average.
- This indicator is based on historical data and may not be a reliable indication of the future risk profile of the fund.
- The risk and reward profile shown is not guaranteed to remain the same and may shift over time.
- Counterparty Risk: As the fund may enter into derivative agreements there is a risk that other parties may fail to meet their obligations. This may lead to delays in receiving amounts due to the fund, receiving less than is due or receiving nothing.
- Credit Risk: Fixed interest securities are affected by trends in interest rates and inflation. If interest rates go up the value of capital may fall and vice versa. Inflation will also decrease the real value of capital. The value of a fixed interest security is also affected by its credit rating.
- Currency Risk: As the fund invests in overseas securities movements in exchange rates, when not hedged, may cause the value of your investment to increase or decrease.
- Derivative Risk: The fund invests in derivatives. The use of derivatives may, through gearing, have a larger impact, positive or negative, than if only the underlying investments were held.

## Charges

The ongoing charges figure is based on the last year's expenses and may vary from year to year. It excludes the costs of buying or selling assets for the Fund (unless these assets are shares of another fund). The ongoing charges figure is an estimated figure calculated by the ACD as at the 15th November 2024. Where income is insufficient to pay charges the residual amount will be taken from capital. They exclude portfolio transaction costs, except in the case of an entry/exit charge paid by the fund when buying or selling units in another collective investment undertaking. You may also be charged a dilution levy on entry to or exit from the fund. For any funds undertaking securities lending, the fund will receive 70% of the revenue generated and the remaining 30% will be received by Northern Trust as the securities lending agent. As securities lending revenue sharing does not increase the costs of running the fund, this has been excluded from the ongoing charges.
